At the time of this printing, there are many reports that the 49 year old Supreme Court ruling stating




that women had a

Tract Projects

1. Our 470,000 plus tracts we sent to be shipped to Colombia haven't arrived yet. Please continue to pray for their safe passage and clearing customs.



2. We have ordered **100,000** tracts to be shipped to Bro. Don Rich in Peru. He is to be receiving a shipping container of Bibles this year and asked for us to send tracts to him. We are going to send him cases with multiple titles inside so he can mail them to various missionaries and pastors in Peru. We are hoping to use his warehouse and distribution network as a means to reaching much of South America!



3. We are printing 400,000 tracts now to have prepared for shipment when the warehouse and distribution depot in Honduras is prepared. We are praying that this will be an avenue to distribute literature into all of Central America, especially Guatemala which had

been our initial goal.

4. Currently, we are printing 100,000 tracts to go to the warehouse in Gray, TN for wherever the next shipment of Bibles and literature is headed into Latin America. It's my prayer to raise **\$25,000** to have **1,000,000** ready for future shipments. We have \$4,925 of that in hand so we are going to \$25,000 print them as we have the funds come in. Pray with us for more funds to print tracts!

The Church Forgives Sins

The quotes we will be using come from the Roman Catholic Church's catechism 982 There is no offense, however serious, that the Church cannot forgive. "There is no one, however

wicked and guilty, who may not confidently hope for forgiveness, provided his repentance is honest. This who died for all men desires that in his Church the gates of forgiveness should always be open to anyone who turns away from sin. 986 By Christ's will, the Church possesses the power to forgive the sins of the baptized and exercises it through bishops and priests normally in the sacrament of Penance. 1448 Beneath the changes in discipline and celebration that this sacrament has undergone over the centuries, the same fundamental structure is to be discerned. It comprises two equally essential elements: on the one hand, the acts of the man who undergoes conversion through the action of the Holy Spirit namely, contrition, confession, and satisfaction; on the other, God's action through the intervention of the Church. the Church, who through the bishop and his priests forgives sins in the name of Jesus Christ and determines the manner of satisfaction, also prays for the sinner and does penance with him. (emphasis mine) Thus the sinner is healed and re-established in ecclesial communion.

BUT, what does the Bible say?

Mark 2:5-11 When Jesus saw their faith, he said unto the sick of the palsy, Son, thy sins be forgiven thee. But there was certain of the scribes sitting there, and reasoning in their hearts, Why doth this man thus speak blasphemies? who can forgive sins but God only? And immediately when Jesus perceived in his spirit that they so reasoned within themselves, he said unto them, Why reason ye these things in your hearts? Whether is it easier to say to the sick of the palsy. Thy sins be forgiven thee, or to say, Arise, and take up thy bed, and walk? But that ye may know that the Son of man hath power on earth to forgive sins, (he saith to the sick of the palsy,) I say unto thee, Arise, and take up thy bed, and go thy way into thine house.

Luke 7:47-50 Wherefore I say unto thee, Her sins, which are many, are forgiven; for she loved much: but to whom little is forgiven, the same loveth little.

"Catholicism Vs. Fundamental Christianity". Continued from page 4. And he said unto her, Thy sins are forgiven. And they that sat at meat with him began to say within themselves, Who is this that forgiveth sins also? And he said to the woman, Thy faith hath saved thee; go in peace.

Ephesians 4:32, And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.

COMMENTARY Who alone can and does forgive sin? It's God!

The One True Church

811 "This is the sole Church of Christ, which in the Creed we profess to be one, holy, catholic and apostolic. '256 These four characteristics, inseparably linked with each other, 257 indicate essential features of the Church and her mission. the Church does not possess them of herself: it is Christ who, through the Holy Spirit, makes his Church one, holy, catholic, and apostolic, and it is he who calls her to realize each of these qualities. 816 "The sole Church of Christ [is that] which our Savior, after his Resurrection, entrusted to Peter's pastoral care, commissioning him and the other apostles to extend and rule it.... This Church, constituted and organized as a society in the present world, subsists in (subsistit in) in) the Catholic Church, which is governed by the successor of Peter and by the bishops in communion with him. '267 816 The Second Vatican Council's Decree on Ecumenism explains: "For it is through Christ's Catholic Church alone, which is the universal help toward salvation, that the fullness of the means of salvation can be obtained (emphasis mine) It was to the apostolic college alone, of which Peter is the head, that we believe that our Lord entrusted all the blessings of the New Covenant, in order to establish on earth the one Body of Christ into which all those should be fully incorporated who belong in any way to the People of God."²⁶⁸818 "However, one cannot charge with the sin of the separation those who at present are born into these communities [that resulted from such separation] and in them are brought up in the faith of Christ, and the Catholic Church accepts them with respect and affection as brothers All who have been justified by faith in Baptism are incorporated into Christ; they therefore have a right to be called Christians, and with good reason are accepted as brothers in the Lord by the children of the Catholic Church. "272

BUT, what does the Bible say?

Acts 4:10-12 (Peter preaching) Be it known unto you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom ye crucified, whom God raised from the dead, even by him doth this man stand here before you whole. This is the stone which was set at nought of you builders, which is become the head of the corner. Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.

1 Peter 2:5-7 Ye also, as lively stones, are built up a spiritual house, an holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices, acceptable to God by Jesus Christ. Wherefore also it is contained in the scripture, Behold, I lay in Sion a chief corner stone, elect, precious: and he that believeth on him shall not be confounded. Unto you therefore which believe he is precious: but unto them which be disobedient, the stone which the builders disallowed, the same is made the head of the corner,
